- Posted: June 15, 2011
- Submission Date: August 15, 2011
- Awarded: September 1, 2011
- Grant Amount: \$2,838, 281.00 – for six (6) regions
 - Ranges from \$403,721 to \$629,750 based on region

Tech Prep/Programs of Study Centers Request For Proposal (RFP)

Eligibility

- Ohio public colleges/universities
- Career-Technical Planning Districts (CTPD's)
- Tech Prep consortia funded in FY11
- High Schools That Work (HSTW) Regional Centers
- Educational Service Centers (ESC's)

Tech Prep/Programs of Study Centers Request For Proposal (RFP)

- Goal: Expansion of State enrollment in Tech Prep/Program of Study Programs
- First Priority – Curriculum alignment and articulation work for Program of Study
- Second Priority – College ready assessment for secondary Tech Prep/Program of Study students

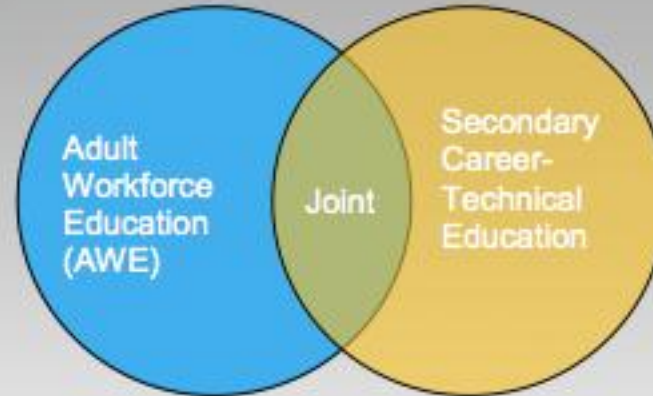
